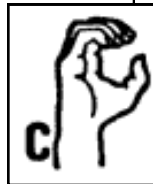

in the way God says it should.



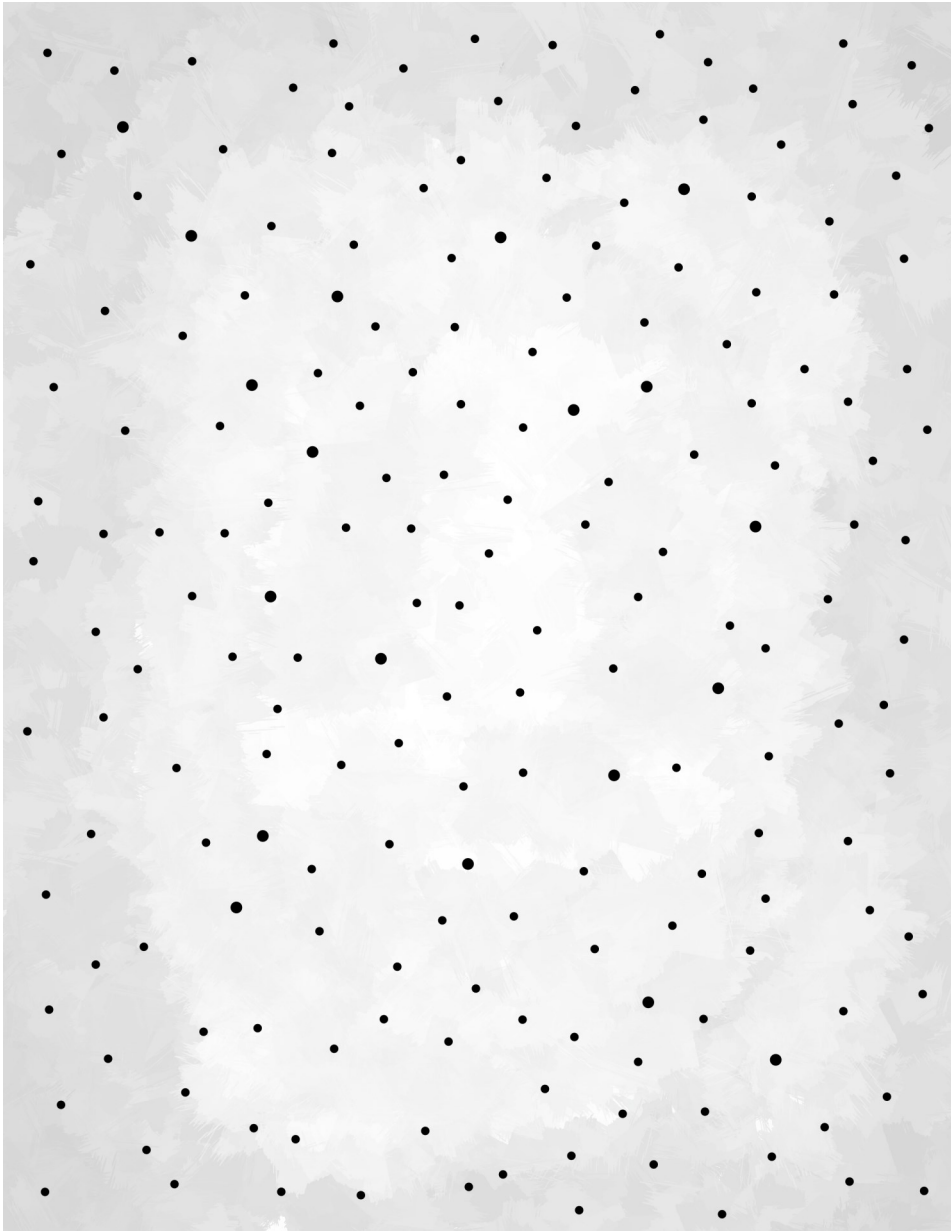

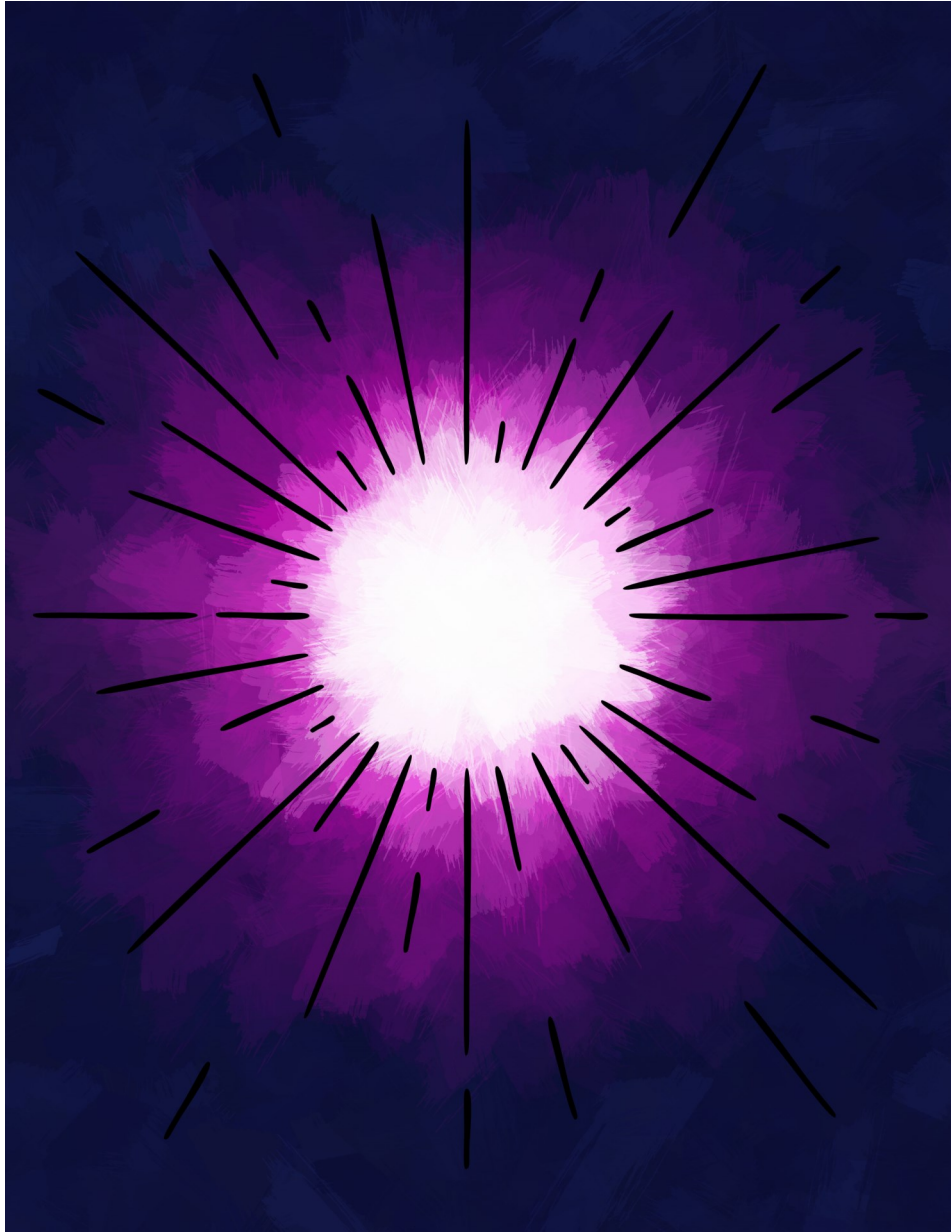
On the sixth day God made animals

to fill the sea and air.

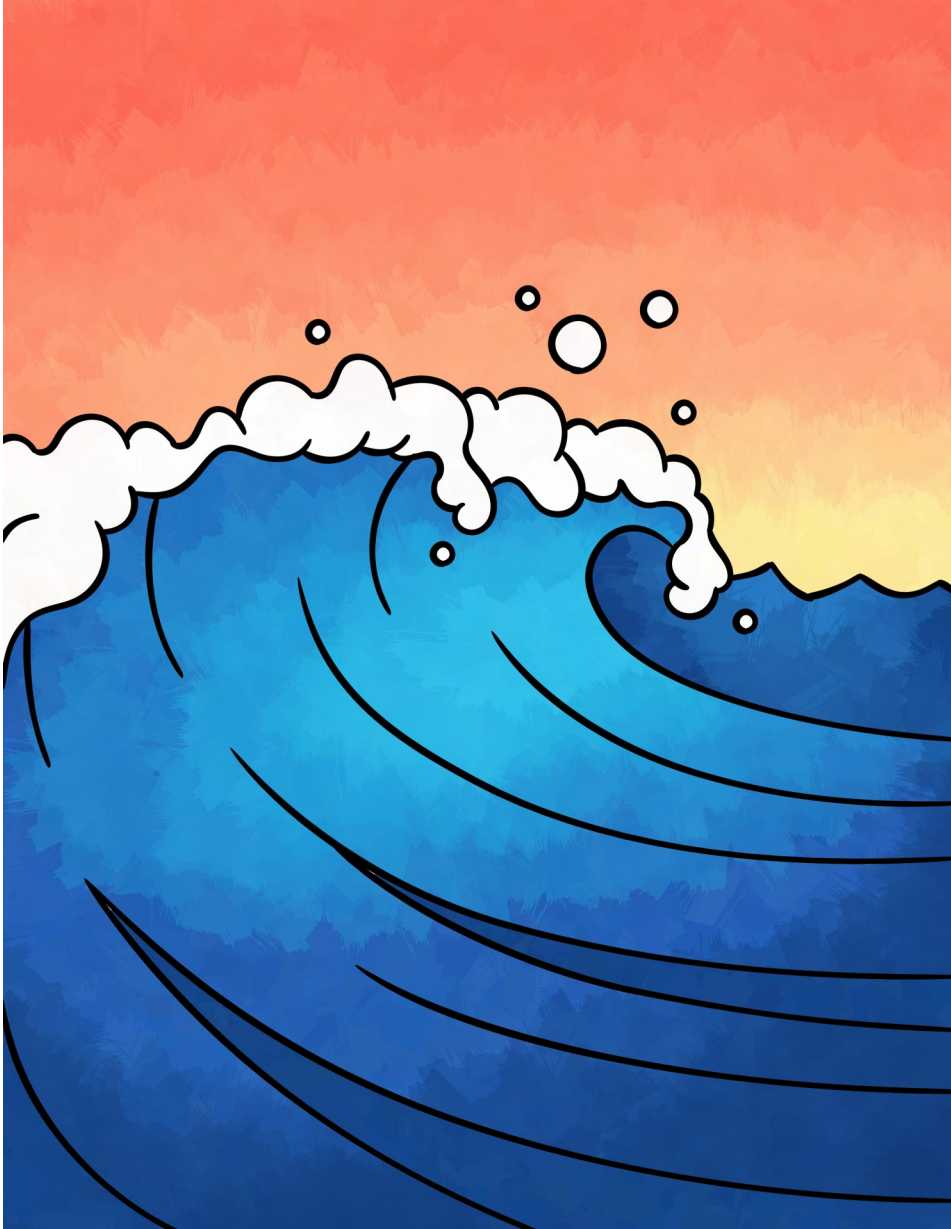
The birds he made with feathers

as God planned them be.



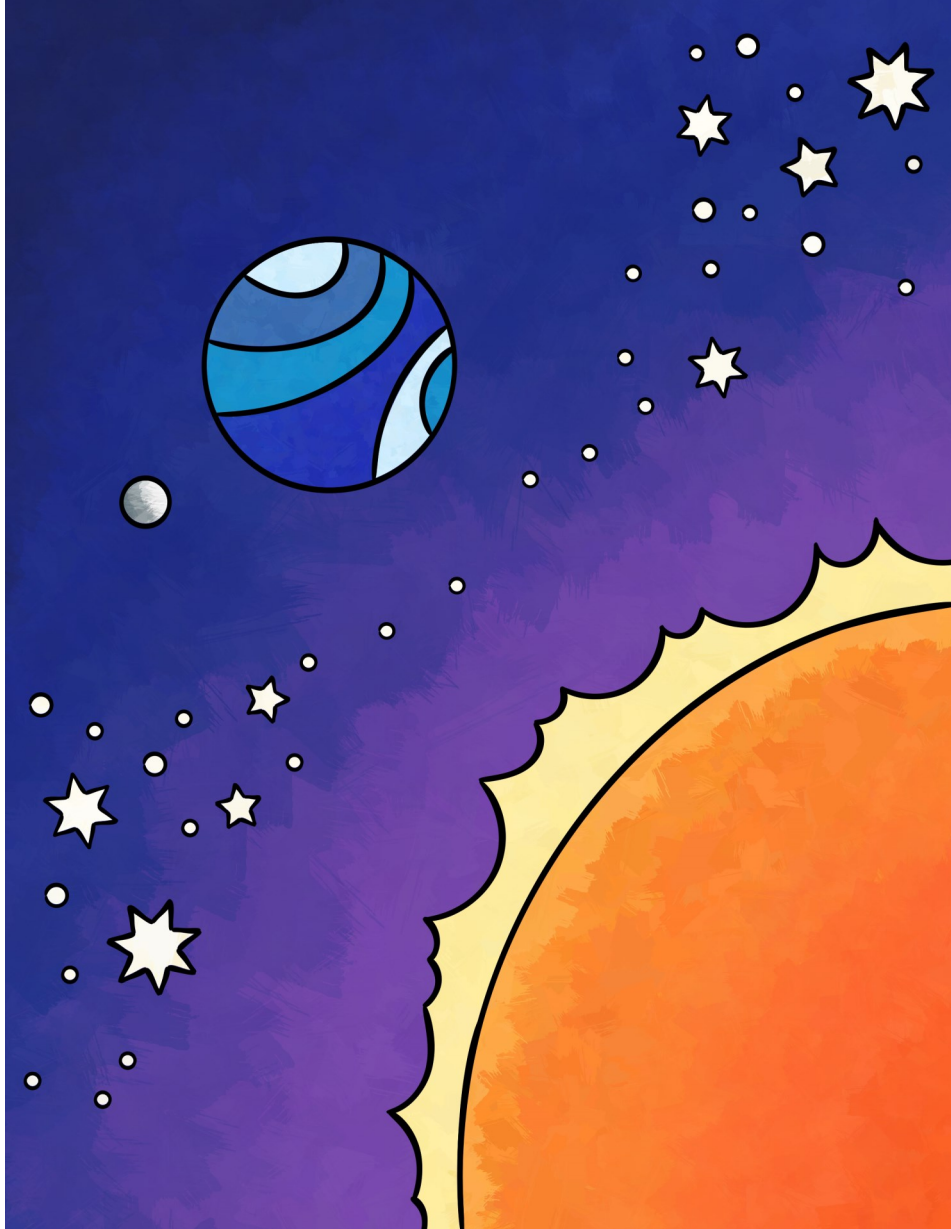
The first act of creation
