

The Father sees us perfect through the work that Christ has done.






When Jesus died upon the cross;

just like he always said.




The Father sent his Son to earth so men could know the way,

Because only what is perfect


can be in heaven at his side.

is that God is far away.




Before the ruler he was brought; victory seemed lost.

Christ did everything he could.




Since the Father and the Son are one,
