## Hebrews 11:24-28 Moses lived by faith.

Moses wrote the first five books of the Bible. He was a man of great faith; he trusted and followed God in all circumstances.
${ }^{24}$ By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ${ }^{25}$ choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, ${ }^{26}$ esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.
${ }^{27}$ By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible. ${ }^{28}$ By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.
