Beginning 38 – Activities

✓ Activity: Acrostic Poem

Instructions: Write an acrostic poem with the word "Righteous" that explains how we become righteous and what becoming righteous enables us to do. Examples are given below.

- R Recognize need for Jesus, repent from sin, rejoice in God
- I Increase in faith, interact with God
- G Give Jesus glory, Give God honor
- H Honor Jesus' sacrifice, help others, hope of eternal life
- T Talk with God, Take what God wants to give you, trust God completely
- E Enter a relationship with Jesus, exchange old self for new self, exalt God
- O Obey God, Open heart to Jesus
- U Understand all God has done, uncover sin
- S See yourself as you really are, satisfy self with Jesus

Craft: Ram

As a reminder that God asked Abraham to sacrifice his son and then provided a ram as a substitute as God has sacrificed his Son for us as a substitute, make a ram.

Materials: cover stock paper, cotton balls, glue sticks, colored pencils

Preparation: Run of craft 38 on cover stock paper

Instructions: Color in the details of the ram and bush. Fold the paper back along the gray lines. Glue cotton to the ram. Glue the flap of the fold to the back of the ram so it stands up.

o **Game:** Find the ram

As a reminder of the ram that was caught in the bushes and was to be offered as a sacrifice instead of Isaac, play hide the ram.

Instruction: Run off a picture of a ram. Select a child to hide it so only a small piece of it is showing while the other children hide their eyes. Let the children walk around to see if they can spot it. Once a child spots it, he sits down and waits for the other children to find it. The first one to spot it gets to hide it the next time.
