

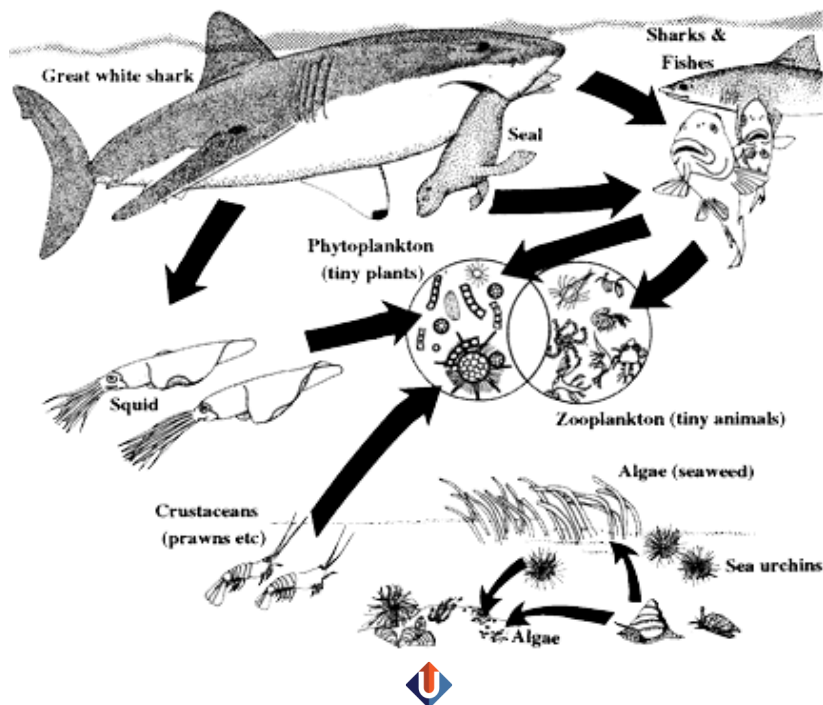

Plankton—Drift with the ocean currents

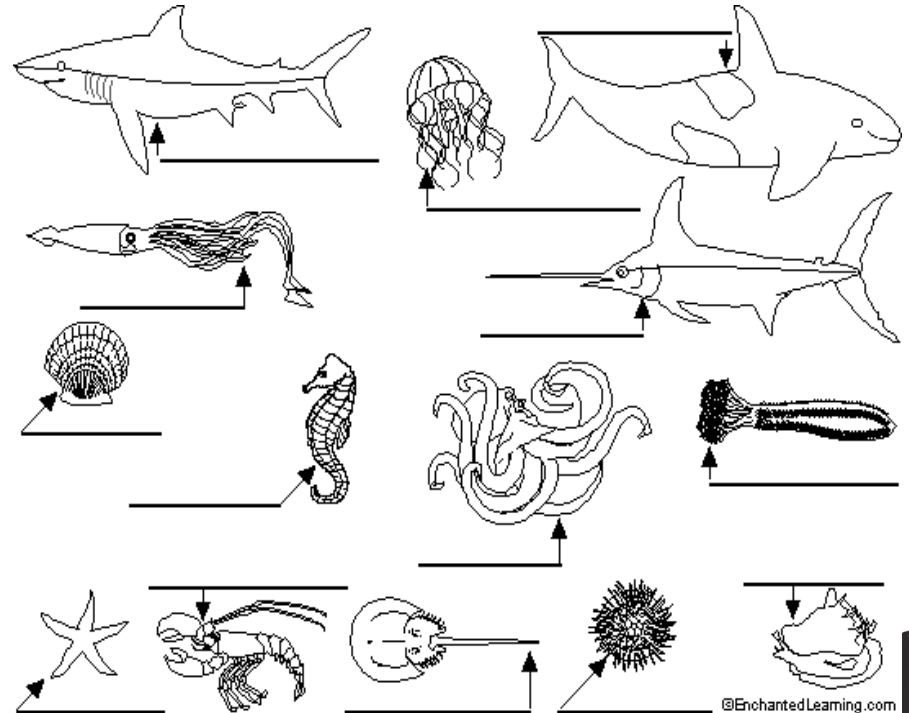
Nekton—Move and swim freely in the ocean
