Even through the night,

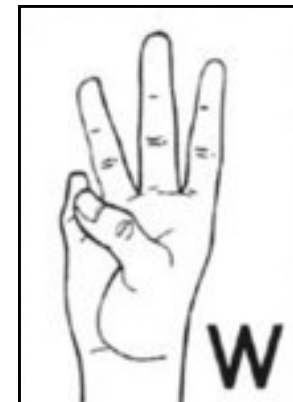
good watch they had to keep.
