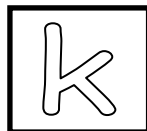
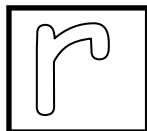
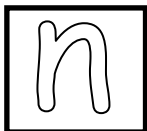

Asleep on the hay

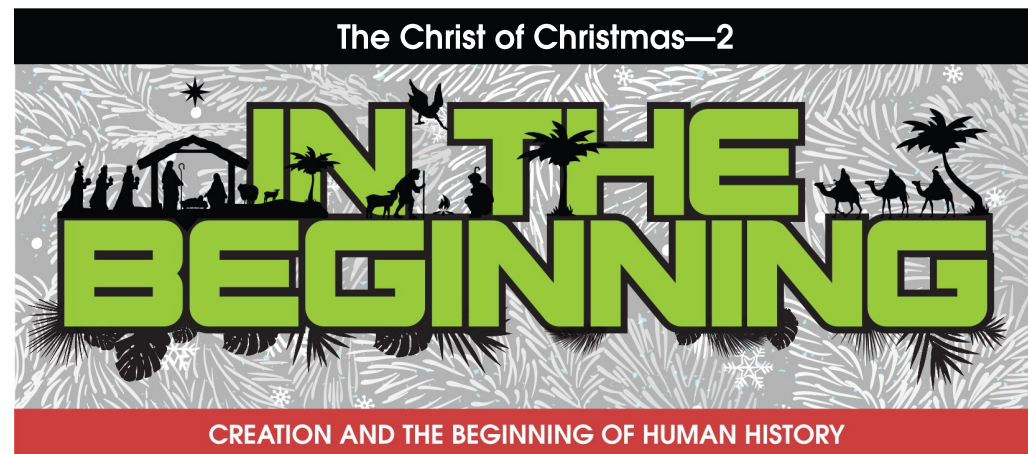
