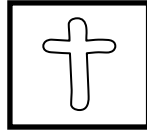
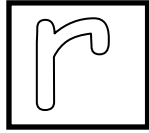

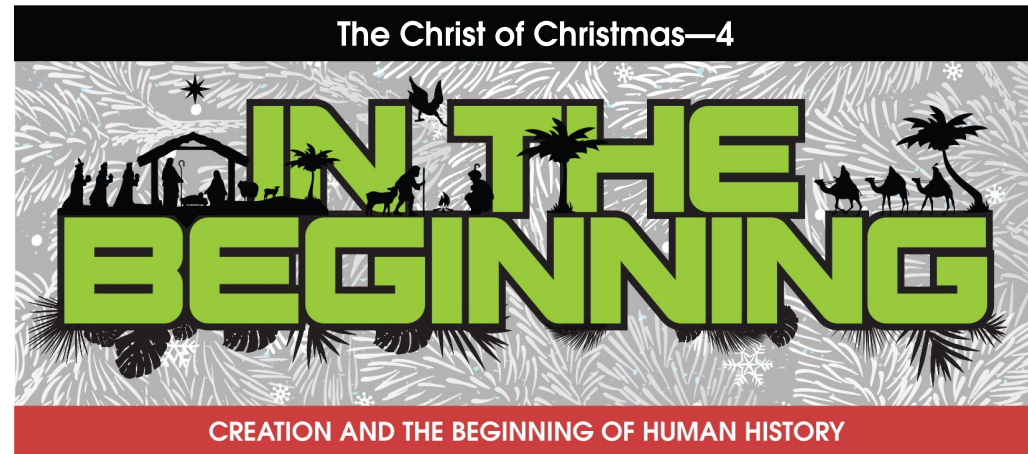

What was the Wise Men's Quest?
