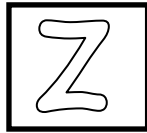
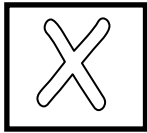

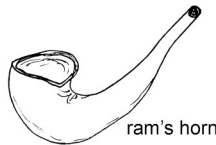


# How Should We Respond to God?

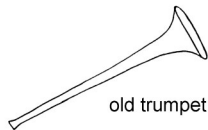

One way the Bible talks about exalting God is by singing and making music to him. King David played a harp. Name the other instruments that were used in Bible times to praise God.

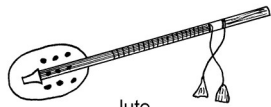
Old Testament musical instruments



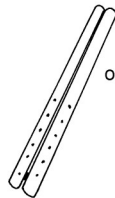

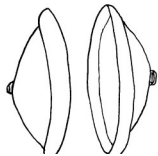
