



#24 - The Fall of Man Genesis 3:1-13

PICTURES NEEDED

24-1 Adam and Eve with the serpent

NURSERY CONCEPT

If we want what is wrong we will sin.

LESSON CONTENT

Show the visual. (Picture 24-1)

What is this a picture of?

Adam and Eve lived in the beautiful garden God had planted for them. Everything was peaceful in the Garden. God had only told them one thing they shouldn't do and that was not to eat the fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. God said that they would die if they ate that fruit. Satan came in the form of a serpent and tempted Eve. Eve ate the fruit and gave some to Adam to eat. They disobeyed God and brought sin and death into the world. If we want what is wrong we will sin like Adam and Eve did.

QUESTIONS

Where did Adam and Eve live? What had God told them not to do? Why did Eve eat the fruit? Why did Adam eat the fruit? What happened when they ate the fruit?

PRAYER

Pray that you would want to do what is right and not sin like Adam and Eve did.

What causes us to sin?
