PICTURES NEEDED

25-1 Adam and Eve leaving the Garden

NURSERY CONCEPT

Because Adam sinned, we are sinners too.

LESSON CONTENT

Show the visual. (Picture 25-1)

What is this a picture of?

When Adam and Eve ate the fruit God told them not to eat, sin entered the world. God had to punish Adam and Eve for the bad thing they had done. He told the man that he would have to work hard to get food to eat. He told the woman that she would have a lot of pain when she gave birth to a baby. Their marriage would no longer be perfect like it was when God gave Eve to Adam as his wife.

God also sent them out of the Garden so they couldn't eat from the Tree of Life and live forever. If they could live forever, their sin would get worse and worse. When Adam and Eve sinned death entered the world and God's good creation didn't work the way God had designed it to. Because Adam sinned we are also sinners and want to do what is wrong. We have to learn to do what is right.

QUESTIONS

What happened when Adam and Eve ate the fruit God had told them not to eat?
Why couldn't they leave in the wonderful garden anymore? What are we because of Adam's sin?

PRAYER

Thank Jesus for dying on the cross for your sin. Pray that you would want to do what is good and right.

What was the consequence of the Fall?
