Page 4

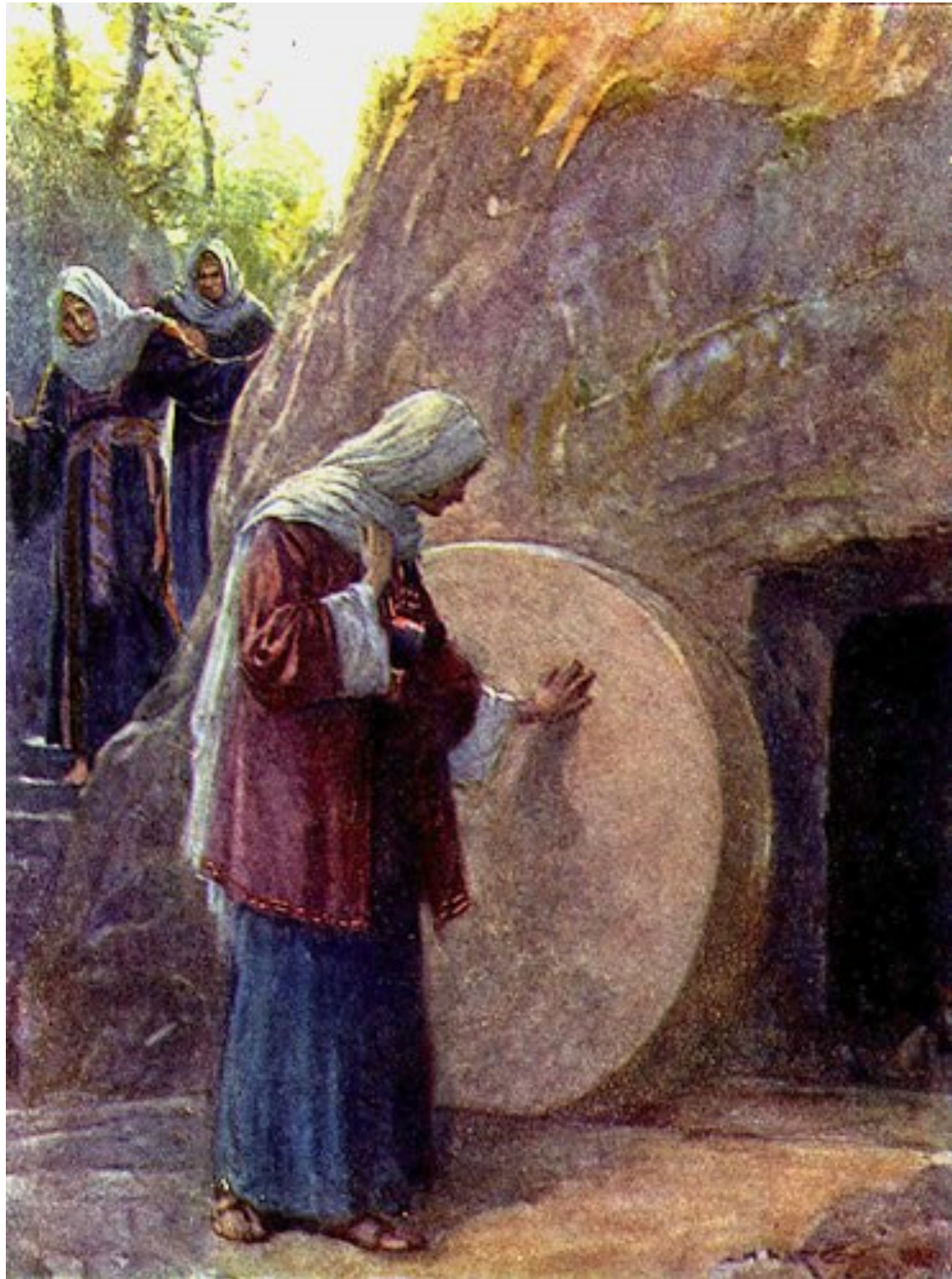
The women went back to the tomb

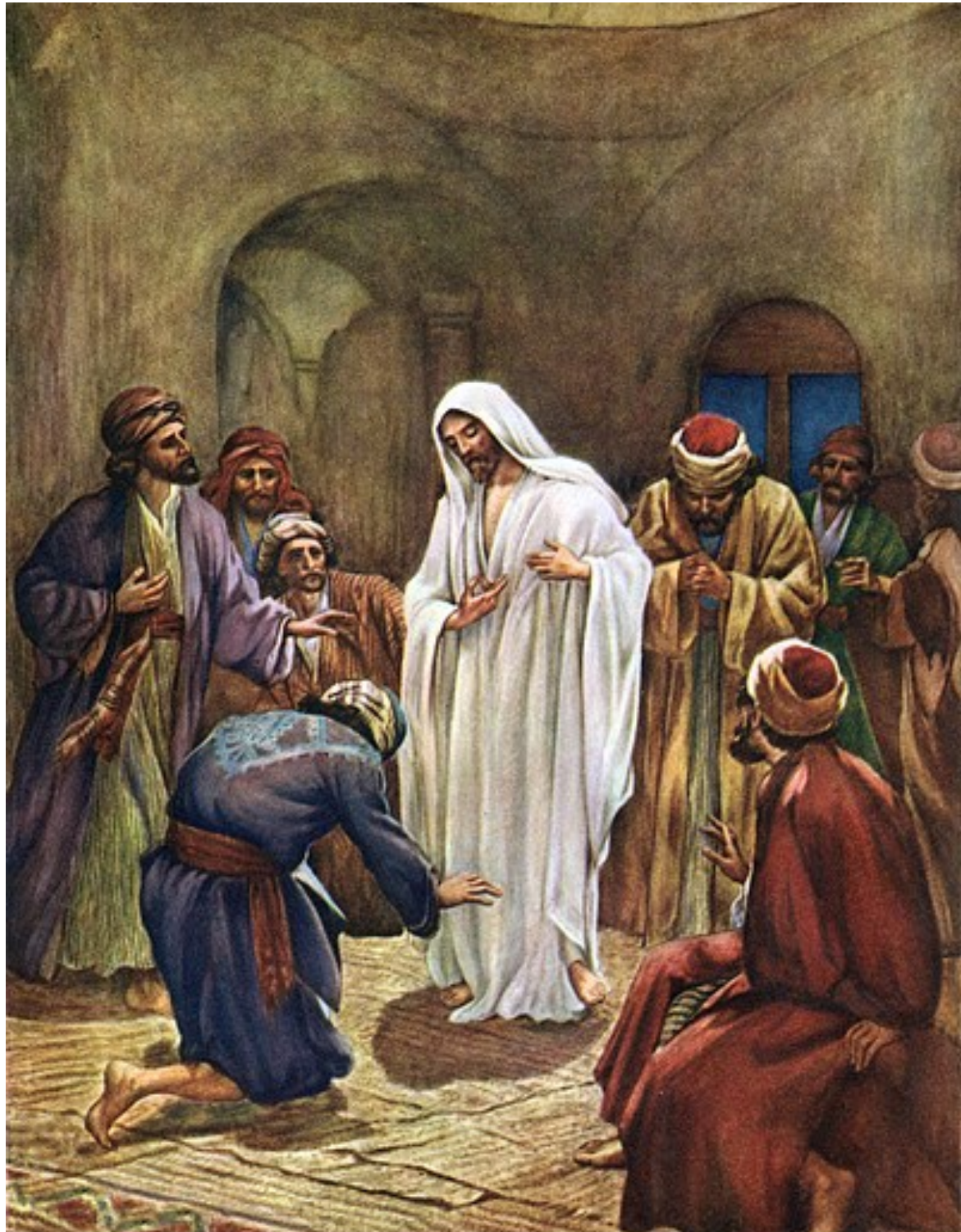
We are blessed when we believe

Move 1<sup>st</sup> 2 fingers of both hands back & forth from mouth
