PICTURES NEEDED

38-2 Isaac on the altar

NURSERY CONCEPT

Abraham trusted God.

LESSON CONTENT

Explanation: (picture 38-2) What is this a picture of?

God tested Abraham's faith to see if Abraham trusted him. God told Abraham to sacrifice his son Isaac. Abraham obeyed God and put his son on the altar. Abraham believed that somehow God would work this out and save his son.

God provided a lamb so Abraham did not have to sacrifice his son. Because Abraham trusted God, God made the offspring (children) of Abraham as numerous as the stars in the sky and the sand on the seashore. God called Abraham righteous because he believed God.

How did God test Abraham's faith? How did Abraham respond to what God asked him to do?

PRAYER

Thank God that he is good and faithful. Pray that you would learn to trust him even when you don't understand what he is doing.

BIG QUESTION

How do we become righteous like Abraham? We become righteous through the sacrifice of Jesus for our sin.
