- They were not to look on Sodom; they were not to turn their head.




The only one to disobey was the one who was Lot's wife.

God did choose to spare.




God destroyed the cities lying in the plain

D—D Make sign of "D"

Destroy Cross palms, move back & make fists

The people Make sign of "P" with both hands, move in circles

did what's bad Make thumbs down sign

D—D—Destroy Same as above

Their evil Make evil face, twist hands by mouth

made God sad Put fists up at eyes like wiping tears
