


How did God test Abraham?

As Abraham took the knife to slay his very precious son.


God said for him to stop,

# How did God test Abraham?

T—T Make sign of "T" with right hand

A sacrifice Make small circles w/ fists in front of body

to be done Open fists up like offering to God
