and with him would stay near.



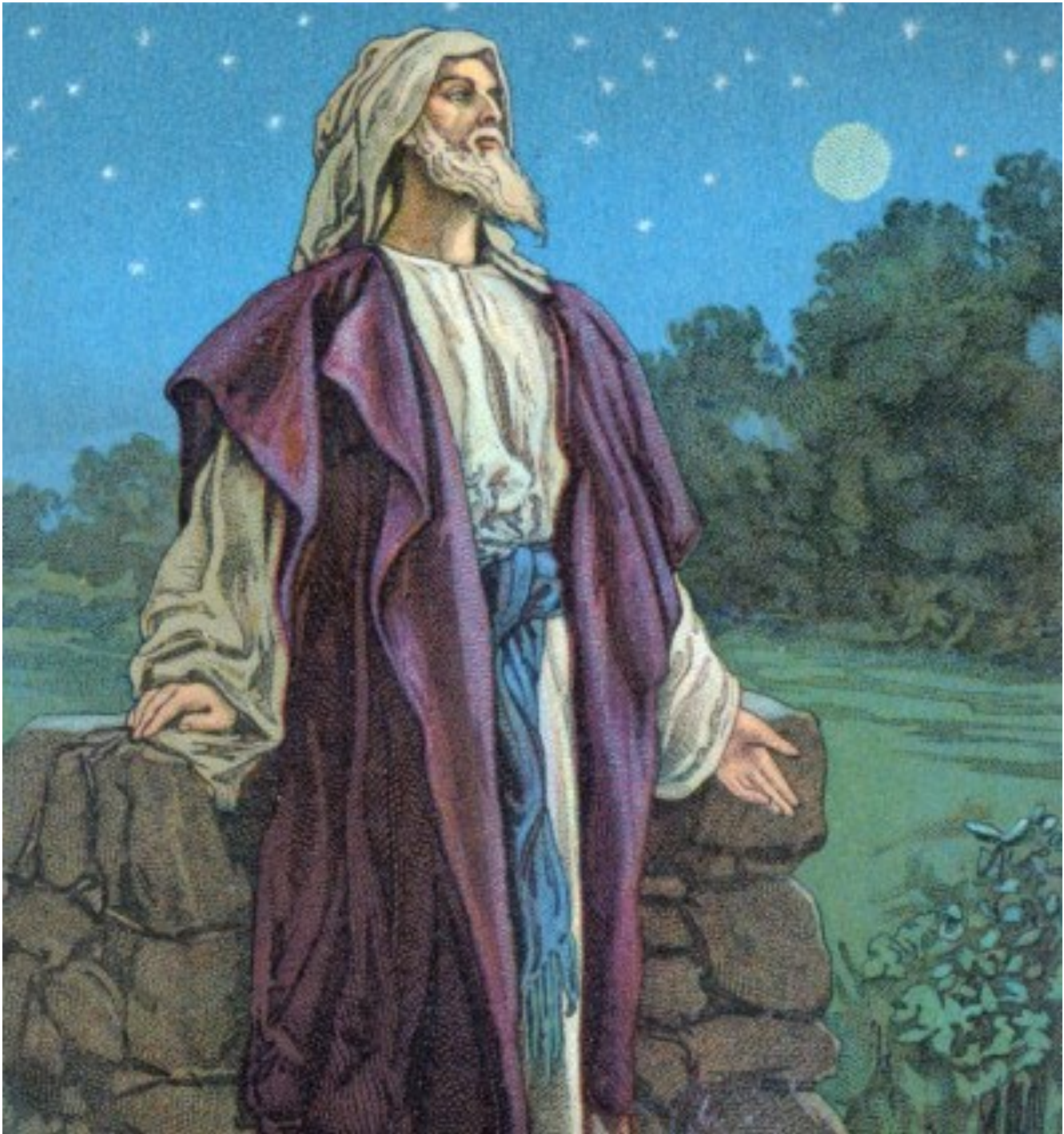
Page 4

And God would never leave him

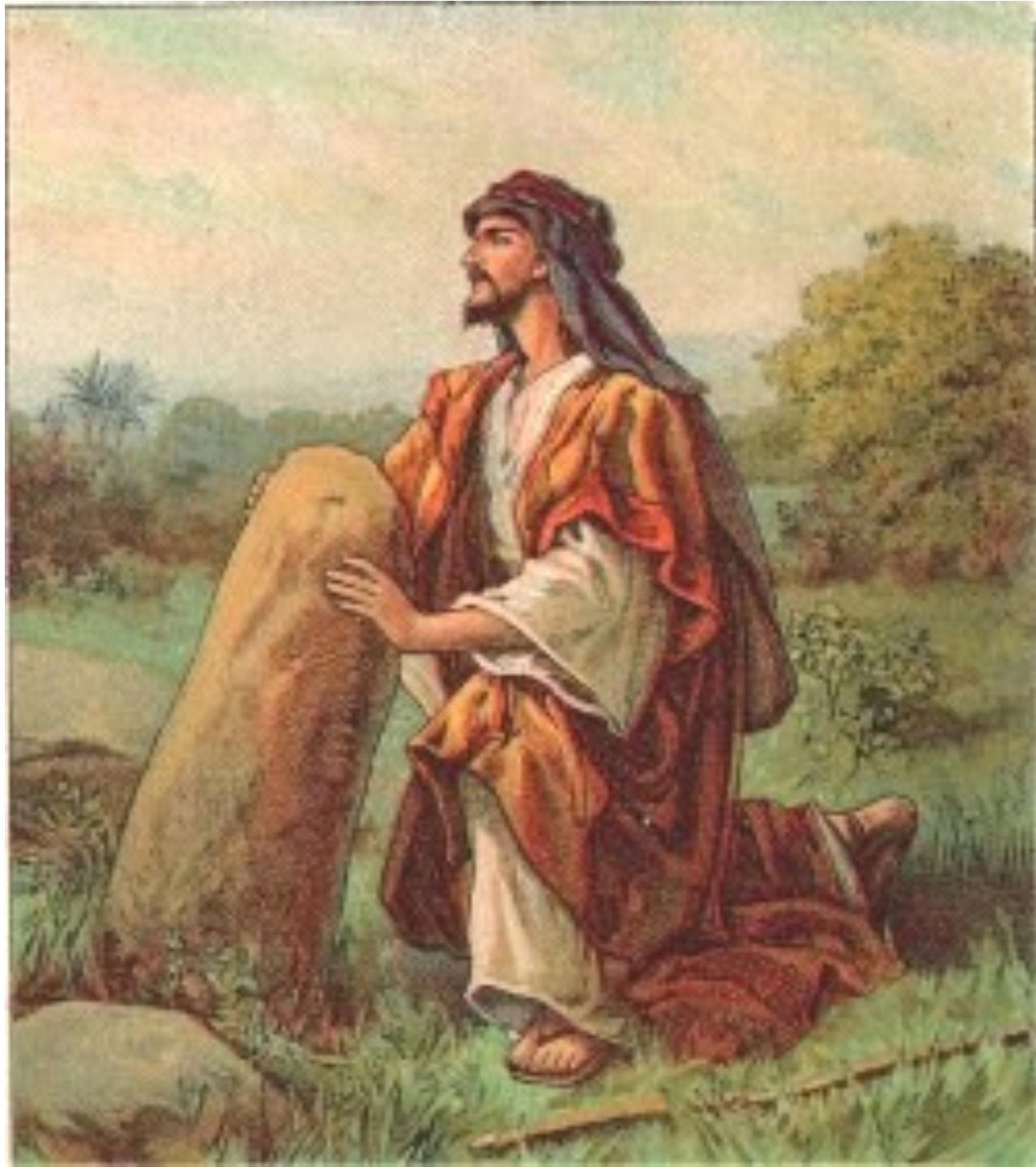
as he traveled east and west.
