


What happened to Joseph?

All bowed down to Joseph's star shining way up high.




To think they'd bow to Joseph made his brothers mad.


Their attitude towards him really was quite bad.

But God was with him in the jail and showed his love and care.




By always doing what was right though he was treated wrong,
