Until they found a stable

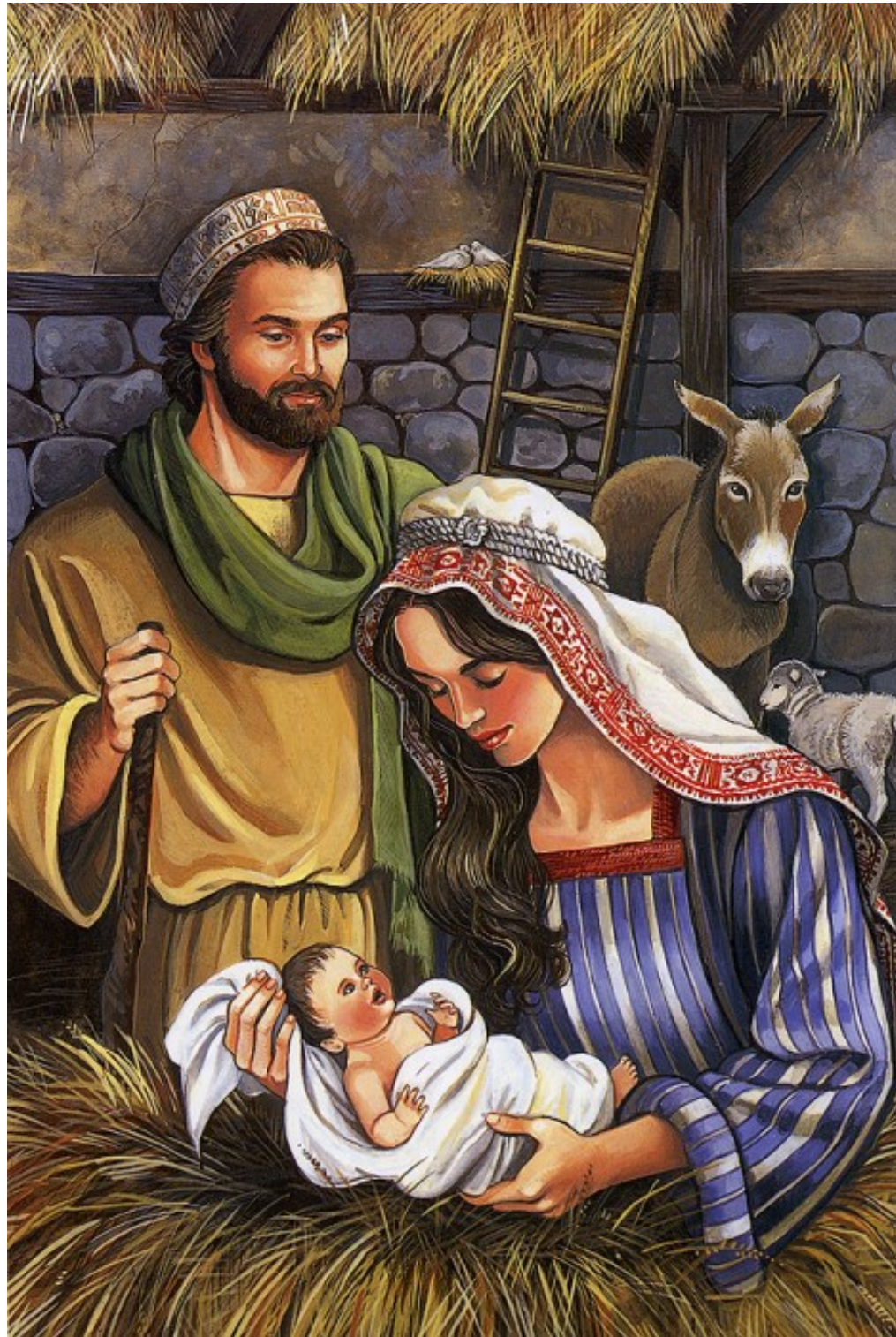
filled with donkeys, cows and sheep.
