


Who is Mary?

As by the Holy Spirit, the child was given life.




Joseph was a good man; he did what God did say.

That had been a prophecy, they both fulfilled that sign.




God had said that Bethlehem would be the birthplace of his Son,

By the king's decree they went to Bethlehem that day.




As they arrived in Bethlehem there was no place to sleep.
