

Level 2—Parent Notes

- ⇒ Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- Completion: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.
- ⇒ Way to go, parents! Your faithfulness in teaching your children the deeds and statutes of the Lord isn't always easy, but it honors God and will have an eternal impact. Keep up the good work! 
What did the prophets say about the Savior?

Draw a baby in the manger to show that Jesus is the one the prophets said would be sent by God.





Daily Reading Questions

<u>Day 1</u>: What is a prophet? What did the prophets say God would do? Why is what they said important?

<u>Day 2</u>: What is a virgin? What did the prophet say the virgin would have? Why is that strange? What would the virgin's son do?

<u>Day 3</u>: Whose line did the prophets say the Savior would come from? What would he do for all people? What is salvation? Why do we need salvation?

<u>Day 4</u>: Where would the Savior be born? What was special about Bethlehem? Why was Jesus born in Bethlehem instead of where his parents lived?

<u>Day 5</u>: Who would God send before the Savior came? What would that person do? What is our shame? Who was the prophet who came before Jesus? How do we know John was the one who was to come first?

<u>Day 6</u>: How do we know Jesus is the Son of God? Why do people reject Jesus? Why is life better when we obey Jesus?

Concluding Lesson

<u>Review</u>: What is a prophet? What is a virgin? What did the prophet say the virgin would have? Whose line did the prophets say the Savior would come from? Where would the Savior be born? Who would God send before the Savior came? How do we know Jesus is the Son of God?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank God for telling the prophets about the coming of the Savior and the signs of his coming. Thank God that we can know Jesus and be sure that he is the Son of God because of the miracles he did and the prophecy he fulfilled.

<u>Application</u>: Prophecy and the teaching of John the Baptist helped prepare people's hearts for the coming of Jesus. Make heart cookies or some other treat to share with your neighbors to tell them about Jesus and the meaning of his coming.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.

Day 1— 2 Peter 1:19

Long ago God's prophets
