

Level 2—Parent Notes

- ⇒ Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- ⇒ <u>Completion</u>: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.

Daily Reading Questions

<u>Day 1</u>: Where were the shepherds? What happened to them there?

<u>Day 2</u>: Why do you think seeing the angels frightened the shepherds? What did the angels tell them? What was the shepherds response to what they were told?

<u>Day 3</u>: What did the shepherds find in the stable? What was their response to seeing Jesus?

<u>Day 4</u>: Where did the wise men live? What did the wise men see in the sky?

<u>Day 5</u>: What did the wise men think the star meant? Why did they go to Judah? Why did they stop and see the king?

<u>Day 6</u>: Why did the wise men go to Bethlehem? What did they find in Bethlehem? What did they give to Jesus? Why did they give gifts to Jesus?

Concluding Lesson

Review: What happened to the shepherds in the fields? What did the angels tell them? What was the shepherds response to what they were told? Where did the wise men live? What did the wise men see in the sky? What did the wise men think the star meant? Why did they go to Bethlehem? What did they give to Jesus?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank God that everything about Jesus' birth shows he is the Son of God. Thank him for sending his Son to save you from your sin and make a way for you to love and follow him.

<u>Application</u>: Confess any sin that would separate you from God and thank Jesus for forgiving you when you sin.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.



DAILY JOURNAL 4—What should we celebrate?
