

Level 2—Parent Notes

- ⇒ <u>Daily Journal</u>: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the *Daily Reading Questions*. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- ⇒ <u>Completion</u>: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.

Daily Reading Questions

<u>Day 1</u>: Where did Mary and Joseph take Jesus after he was born? Why did they do that?

<u>Day 2</u>: What did Mary and Joseph buy two pigeons for? What is a sacrifice? Why did Mary and Joseph offer the pigeons as a sacrifice?

<u>Day 3</u>: Who was Simeon? What did God show Simeon?

<u>Day 4</u>: What was Simeon's prophecy? How did Mary and Joseph respond to the prophecy?

<u>Day 5</u>: Who was Anna? What did Anna do when she saw Jesus?

<u>Day 6</u>: Where did Mary and Joseph go back to live? What does despise mean? What does that mean Nazareth was like? Why do you think God chose Nazareth as the place for Jesus to grow up?

Concluding Lesson

Review: Where did Mary and Joseph take Jesus after he was born? Why did Mary and Joseph offer the pigeons as a sacrifice? Who was Simeon? What did God show Simeon? Who was Anna? What did Anna do when she saw Jesus? Where did Mary and Joseph go back to live?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank God for all the people who told others who Jesus was. Pray that you would see clearly all Jesus is and has done for you and share that with others.

<u>Application</u>: Think of a job you can do to help out your church remembering how Simeon and Anna were faithful servants of God.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.

DAILY JOURNAL 5—How was Jesus dedicated to God?

Day 1—Luke 2:21

The Jews they are God's people and when a baby's born,
