

#10 - The Choosing of the Disciples Luke 5:1-11, 27-32, 6:12-16

PICTURES NEEDED

10-1 Jesus calling Peter

NURSERY CONCEPT

Jesus calls his followers to fish for men

LESSON CONTENT

Explanation: (Show lesson picture) (picture 10-1)

What is this a picture of?

Peter, James and John were fishermen. One day Jesus got into their boat and then told them to go out and fish again even though they had been doing that and hadn't caught any fish. When Peter let down the nets, they filled with fish. This miracle caused him to fall down at Jesus' feet and tell Jesus that he was a sinner. Jesus called Peter, James and John to leave everything and follow him. They became his disciples.

A lot of people followed Jesus around and listened to his teaching, but Jesus picked only twelve of them to be his very special disciples. To be a disciple means to be a follower. Jesus told his disciples that they would fish for men.

QUESTIONS

What did Jesus tell Peter to do? What happened when Peter did that? What did Jesus call Peter to be? What is a disciple?

PRAYER

Thank God that you can follow Jesus and be his disciple. Pray that you would want to do what makes him happy and tell others about him.

BIG QUESTION (This is for reference only. The nursery children are not expected to learn it.)
