Who are Jesus' disciples?

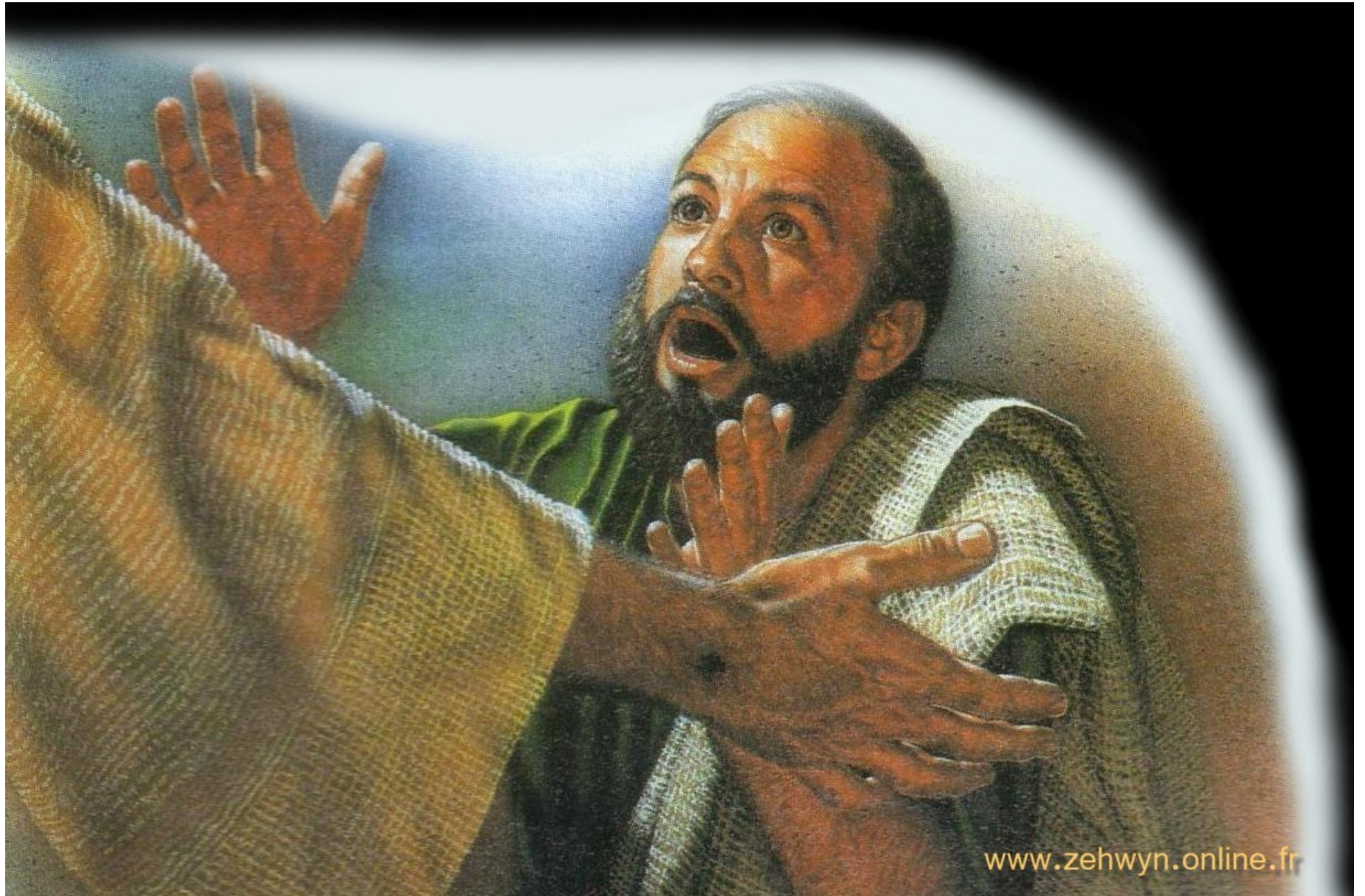
