What are the Beatitudes?

B—B	Make sign of "B"
Beatitudes	Fists in front of mouth, open & spread hands out in front palms down
Teach what is right to do	Fingers of hands touching thumbs, Move by sides of head & then forward Make thumbs up sign
B—B—Beatitudes	Same as above
Jesus	Make sign of Jesus
speaks of what is true	Two fingers from each hand going back & forth from mouth R index finger in front of mouth, move finger forward to point straight out
