17 For what need hath he that
 into the world to condemn the
 world? but that the world
 through him might be saved?
 18 For that believeth on him
 has not condemnation: but he that
 believeth not is condemned al-
 ready, because he hath not be-
 lieved in the name of the only
 begotten Son of God.
 19 And this is the condemna-
 tion, that light is come into the
 world, and men loved darkness
 rather than light, because their
 deeds were evil.
 20 For every one that doeth
 evil hateth the light, neither com-
 eth to the light, lest his deeds
 should be reproved.
 21 But he that doeth truth com-
 eth to the light, that his deeds
 may be made manifest, that
 they are wrought in God.
 22 After these things came
 Jesus and his disciples into the
 land of Judæa; and there he
 tarried with them, and was
 baptized.
 23 And John also was baptiz-
 ing in Æ'nôn near to Sa'mim,
 because there was much water
 there: and they came, and were
 baptized.
 24 For John was not yet cast
 into prison.
 25 Then there arose a ques-
 tion between some of John's dis-
 ciples and the Jews about puri-
 fying.
 26 And they came unto John,
 and said unto him, Rabbi, he
 that was with thee beyond Jor-
 dan, to whom thou barest wit-
 ness, behold, the same baptiz-
 eth, and all men come to him.
 27 John answered and said,
 A man can receive nothing,
 except it be given him from heav-
 en.
 28 Ye yourselves bear me wit-
 ness, that I said, I am not the
 Christ, but that I am sent be-
 fore him.
 29 He that hath the bride is
 the bridegroom: but the friend
 of the bridegroom, which stand-
 eth and heareth him, rejoiceth
 greatly because of the bride-

groom.
 30 My joy is full, because I
 have heard his voice; and I
 have said, I will be his friend,
 and will stand by him, and
 hear his voice, which giveth
 life: and this joy mine is
 fulfilled.
 31 He that receiveth his
 witness, the witness that God
 beareth of the Son whom
 he hath sent.
 32 And who receiveth his
 witness, he that receiveth
 the life through the Son
 whom God hath sent.
 33 He that receiveth not his
 witness, the judgment is
 already pronounced against
 him, because he hath not
 believed in the name of the
 only begotten Son of God.
 34 For the Son whom God
 hath sent speaketh the words
 of God, and no man receiveth
 his witness, because he hath
 not seen him.
 35 The Father loveth the Son,
 and hath given all things into
 his hand.
 36 He that believeth on the
 Son hath everlasting life: and
 he that believeth not the Son
 shall not see life; but the
 wrath of God abideth on him.

CHAPTER 4
 WHEN therefore the Lord knew
 that the Pharisees had heard
 that Jesus made and baptized
 more disciples than John,
 2 (Though Jesus himself bap-
 tized not, but his disciples,)
 3 He left Judæa, and departed
 again into Galilee.
 4 And he must needs go
 through Sa-má'ri-a.
 5 Then cometh he to a city
 of Sa-má'ri-a, which is called Sy'-
 char, near to the parcel of
 ground that Jacob gave to his
 son Joseph.
 6 Now Jacob's well was there.
 Jesus therefore, being wearied
 with his journey, sat thus on the
 well: and it was about the sixth
 hour.
 7 There cometh a woman of
 Sa-má'ri-a to draw water: Jesus
 saith unto her, Give me to drink.
 8 (For his disciples were gone
 away unto the city to buy meat.)
 9 Then saith the woman of Sa-
 má'ri-a unto him, How is it that
 thou, being a Jew, askest drink
 of me, which am a woman of
 Sa-má'ri-a? for the Jews have
