

Level 2—Parent Notes

- Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- Completion: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.



<u>Day 6</u>: How can we be a disciple of Jesus? What should we do if we are a disciple of Jesus? What will be the result of following Jesus?

Concluding Lesson

<u>Review</u>: Who were Jesus' disciples? How many disciples did Jesus have? What did Jesus want his disciples to do? How can you be disciple of Jesus?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank Jesus for the truth he taught and showed his disciples. Pray that you would learn to love and obey Jesus like they did.

<u>Application</u>: Think of something nice you can do for another person to show that you love Jesus.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.
