

# **Level 2—Parent Notes**

- Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- Completion: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.

### **Daily Reading Questions**

<u>Day 1</u>: What is a miracle? What was the first miracle Jesus did? How do miracles show that Jesus came from God?

<u>Day 2</u>: How did Jesus get to his disciples in a boat? Why would they have been terrified? Why would they have worshipped Jesus when they saw what he did?

<u>Day 3</u>: Why were the people in the crowd hungry? How did they get fed? What do you think the people thought after that?

<u>Day 4</u>: What is a paralytic? How did the paralytic get to Jesus? What two things did Jesus do for the paralytic? Which was most important for the man? Why?

<u>Day 5</u>: What was the greatest miracle that Jesus did? What is that such a great miracle? What does rising from the dead show about Jesus?

<u>Day 6</u>: What kind of miracles did the Apostles do? Why did they do miracles? How do miracles help people come to know Jesus?

## **Concluding Lesson**

<u>Review</u>: What is a miracle? What was the first miracle Jesus did? What are other miracles Jesus did? How do miracles show that Jesus came from God?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank God that he is God and different from men. Thank him for sending his Son to save you from your sin. Thank him for the miracles that Jesus did that show he is the Son of God and your Savior.

<u>Application</u>: Read to the child about a miracle Jesus did from a Bible story book. Have the child practice telling the story and then share it with someone else.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.

Miracles Put hands up in surprised gesture


Show Jesus Make sign of Jesus
