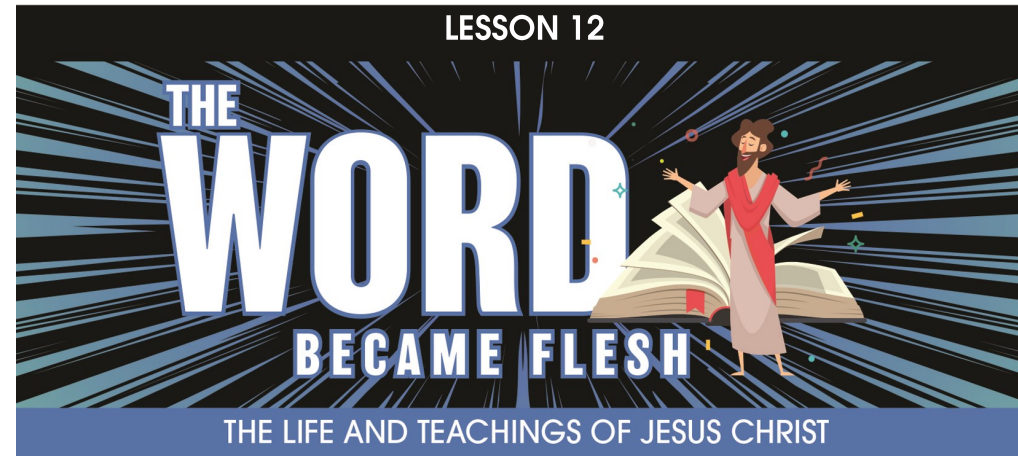

Level 2—Parent Notes

- ⇒ **Daily Journal:** Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the *Daily Reading Questions*. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ **Lesson Rhyme:** Read the *Lesson Rhyme* on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the *Lesson Rhyme Signs*.
- ⇒ **Concluding Lesson:** Complete the activities under *Concluding Lesson* in the booklet.
- ⇒ **Completion:** If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.
- ⇒ **Way to go, parents!** Your faithfulness in teaching your children the deeds and statutes of the Lord isn't always easy, but it honors God and will have an eternal impact. Keep up the good work! Daily Reading Questions

Day 1: What is the difference between the two paths we can choose to follow? What will happen if we choose to follow God’s path?

Day 2: What shows we love Jesus? What does Jesus do for us when we sin? Why does the Father listen to the Son? What does that mean?

Day 3: What does it mean to love our brother? What does loving our brother show? What happens when God’s love isn’t in us? Why is that?

Day 4: What will happen to all the things of the world? What is the only thing that lasts forever? What does that mean we should do? Why?

Day 5: What did Jesus do for us? What does that mean we should do?

Day 6: What is the choice set before you? What choice leads to a good life? Why does that choice make for a good life?

Concluding Lesson

Review: What is the difference between the two paths we can choose to follow? What will happen if we choose to follow God’s path? What shows we love Jesus? What does Jesus do for us when we sin? What will happen to all the things of the world? What is the only thing that lasts forever?

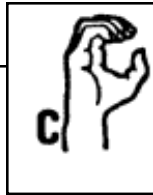

DAILY JOURNAL 12 — Who should we choose to follow?

Day 1— 1 John 1:7
