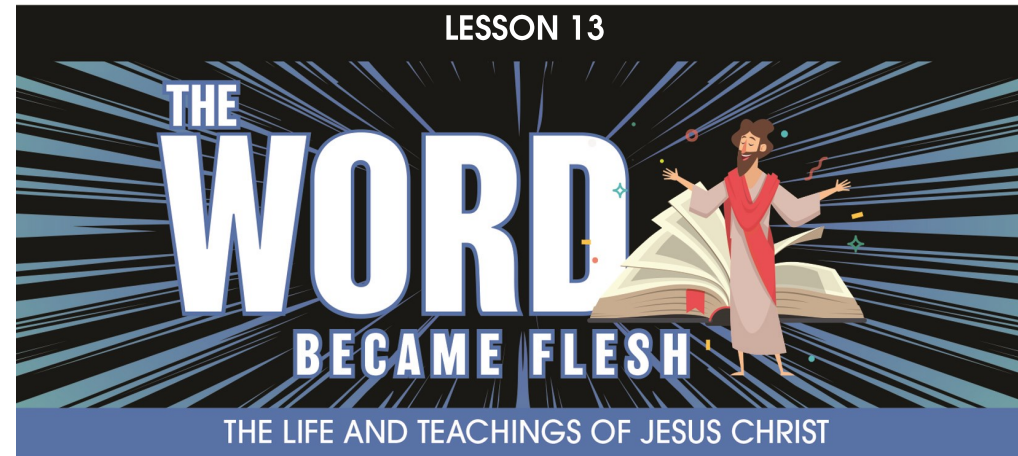

Level 2—Parent Notes

- ⇒ **Daily Journal:** Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the *Daily Reading Questions*. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ **Lesson Rhyme:** Read the *Lesson Rhyme* on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the *Lesson Rhyme Signs*.
- ⇒ **Concluding Lesson:** Complete the activities under *Concluding Lesson* in the booklet.
- ⇒ **Completion:** If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.
- ⇒ **Way to go, parents!** Your faithfulness in teaching your children the deeds and statutes of the Lord isn't always easy, but it honors God and will have an eternal impact. Keep up the good work! Daily Reading Questions

Day 1: Why did people come to Jesus? What did Jesus want the people to learn? What did Jesus do for the people?

Day 2: Where did Jesus teach the Beatitudes? What do the Beatitudes teach about?

Day 3: What will happen to the poor on earth? What will happen to those who are hungry?

Day 4: What will happen to those who are sad? What will happen to those who men hate because they believe in Jesus?

Day 5: What will happen to those who have everything they need on earth? Why?

Day 6: What hard thing does Jesus say for us to do? Who are our enemies? What will happen if we love our enemies?

Concluding Lesson

Review: Where did Jesus teach the Beatitudes? What do the Beatitudes teach about? What will happen to those who have everything they need on earth? Why?

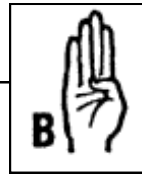

Dictation: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.

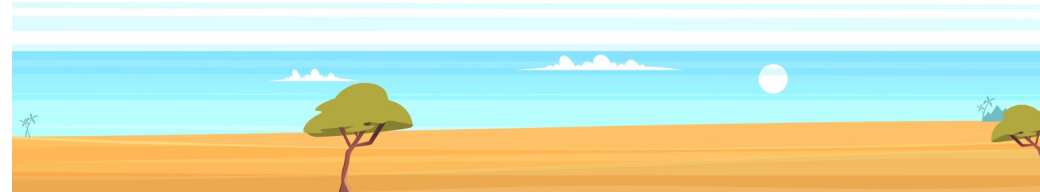

Lesson Rhyme Signs

B—B	Make sign of "B"
Beatitudes	Fists in front of mouth, open & spread hands out in front palms down
Teach what	Fingers of hands touching thumbs
is right to do	Move by sides of head & then forward
B—B—Beatitudes	Make thumbs up sign
Jesus	Same as above
speaks of	Make sign of Jesus
what is true	Two fingers from each hand going back & forth from mouth
	R index finger in front of mouth, move finger forward to point straight out



DAILY JOURNAL 13 — What are the Beatitudes?

Day 1 — Luke 6:17-18a

Many people came to Jesus,
because he had the power to heal.
But Jesus wanted them to learn,
of God and what is real.
So he would teach the people
what was right to do.
He always did the Father's will
and spoke of what is true.

Day 2 — Matthew 5:10

The Beatitudes he taught
in the Sermon on the Mount.

Day 3 — Luke 6:21-21a
