NURSERY CONCEPT

Faith is believing Jesus.

LESSON CONTENT

Explanation: (Show lesson picture) (picture 15-1)

What is this a picture of?

A centurion, who was the leader of 100 soldiers, sent for Jesus because his servant was sick and he believed Jesus could heal him if Jesus wanted to.

When Jesus was on the way to the centurion's house, the centurion sent his friends to tell him just to speak the word to heal his servant because he wasn't worthy to have Jesus come into his home.
