## #16 – The Anointing of the Sinful Woman Luke 7:18-50

### PICTURES NEEDED

16-2 Sinful woman anointing Jesus' feet

### NURSERY CONCEPT

Jesus forgives our sin

### LESSON CONTENT

Explanation: (Show lesson picture) (picture 16-2)

What is this a picture of?

When Jesus was eating dinner at the house of a man named Simon, a sinful woman came and poured oil on his feet and wiped them with her tears. She was humble and loved Jesus. She knew she did bad things and needed forgiveness from God.

Simon, the master of the house, thought that Jesus shouldn't let the woman touch him because she was known to be a bad woman. He was prideful and judged the woman. Simon didn't see that he did bad things and needed forgiveness too. Jesus forgave her sin. Our sin is the bad things we do. We all need forgiveness from Jesus for the bad things that we do.

## QUESTIONS

What did the women do for Jesus? What did the woman know that she needed from Jesus? What are some bad things that you do that you need forgiveness for?

## PRAYER

Thank Jesus that he forgives your sin. Pray that you would want to do things that make him happy and not look at things that other people do wrong.

## BIG QUESTION (This is for reference only. The nursery children are not expected to learn it.)

**What do we do before we judge the sin of others?**

We have to uncover and deal with our own sin first.

## CONCEPT MOVEMENTS

Jesus	Make sign of Jesus
Forgives	Wipe one hand on other & then reverse, like wiping clean
Our sin	Make thumbs down sign
