LESSON CONTENT

• Introduction: (picture 16-2) What is this a picture of?

When Jesus was eating dinner at the house of a man named Simon, a sinful woman came and poured oil on his feet and wiped them with her tears. She was humble and loved Jesus. She knew she was a sinner and needed forgiveness from God.

Simon, the master of the house, thought that Jesus shouldn't let the woman touch him because she was known to be a bad woman. He was prideful and judged the woman. Simon didn't see that he was a sinner and needed Jesus to forgive him too.

To really appreciate all that Jesus has done for us we need to see how much we need forgiveness for our own sin. We need to stop looking at other people and what they do wrong.

Jesus says we need to take the plank out of our own eye before we look at the speck in someone else's eye. What does that mean? We have to see our own sins clearly. If we see our own sin and need for change in our own hearts, we will be much kinder to others. We won't see their sin as being such a big deal.

The big question for this week is: What do we do before we judge the sin of others? Listen as I read the lesson book and see if you can answer the question afterwards.

Lesson Book: Read the book. Refer to the attached discussion questions.

Title: Why should we forgive others?

<u>Page 1 - Luke 23:34</u> (Picture of Jesus on cross) All of us are sinners, we need forgiveness from above. Jesus came to earth to share the fullness of God's love. When Jesus hung upon the cross, he said, "Forgive them for their sin." The same forgiveness to all others, we are to extend.

Page 3 - Luke 6:41,42b (Picture of person looking in mirror) We have to keep in mind that our sin is just the same. We're sometimes mean to others and to Jesus we bring shame. So we don't look at the speck in other people's eyes. We first take out the plank that in our own eye lies. Page 2 - Luke 11:4 (Picture of children fighting) When other people do what's wrong, and make us sad or mad, We forgive them quickly, which makes Jesus really glad. The words we say to others is, "I have forgiven you." Even if they did to us, what isn't right to do.

Page 4 - Colossians 3:13

(Children hugging or helping each other) We examine our own lives to see what we do wrong. Because we want to do what's right, when to Jesus we belong. For all the bad that we have done, we need forgiveness too, So showing others mercy is something that we do. Page 5 - Ephesians 2:4-5 (Picture of people in front of cross) We recognize forgiveness is a gift we daily need. It's a gift that's freely given when to Jesus we do plead. The mercy that God shows us brings us the gift of life. So we turn away from evil, naughtiness and strife. Page 6 - Matthew 6:14-15 (Picture of Jesus with children) In the way that we forgive, to us God will be kind. His love and great forgiveness we will surely find. We want to be like Jesus, showing others love, So through us they will see, the love of God above.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

<u>Page 1:</u> What is sin? Why does everyone need forgiveness for their sin? Who forgives our sin? Why does God forgive our sin? What did Jesus ask the Father to do for the people who nailed him on the cross? Why would that have been hard for him to do?

<u>Page 2:</u> If we are to be like Jesus, what does that mean we are to do when people hurt us?

<u>Page 3:</u> What do we do that shows we need forgiveness? What does it mean to take the plank out of our own eye before we look at the speck in someone else's eye?

<u>Page 4:</u> Why should we examine our lives to see what we do wrong? What is mercy? Why should we show others mercy?

<u>Page 5:</u> Why do we daily need forgiveness? What does God's mercy do for us? What should we do because of God's mercy towards us?

<u>Page 6:</u> When should we forgive others? What happens when we forgive others? Why should we want to be like Jesus? What happens when we do the things Jesus would do?

<u>Review:</u> Select a couple questions from above to ask the students again.

- <u>Prayer</u>: Thank God for the kindness and mercy he has shown you by sending Jesus to die for your sins. Thank him that you are forgiven and he has given you his Spirit so you can choose to go his way and do what is right. Pray that you would show his love and forgive ness to others and quickly forgive people for anything wrong they do to you.
- The Big Question: What do we do before we judge the sin of others?

We have to uncover and deal with our own sin first.

Any age appropriate activity can be included which fits into the club time. The activities with a star are included on the weekly sheet.

- ★ <u>Coloring</u>: Color in the lesson picture.
- ★ <u>Activity</u>: Drawing

Instruction: Draw a foot as a reminder that the woman wiped Jesus' feet with her tears.

★ Lesson Rhyme: Practice the lesson rhyme with movements.

- <u>Discovery Activity:</u> The Sinful Woman <u>Instructions:</u> Act out the story of the sinful woman and Simon.
- <u>Craft:</u> Plank in the eye

As a reminder that we are not to judge others, make a face with a plank in the eye. <u>Materials:</u> cover stock paper, small craft stick, glue, colored pencils <u>Preparation:</u> Run off craft 16 on cover stock paper, cut in half. <u>Instructions:</u> Color in the face to look like you. Glue the stick to your eye.

• <u>Song:</u> River of Life I've got a river of life flowing out of me Makes the lame to walk and the blind to see Opens prison doors, Sets the captive free I've got a river of life flowing out of me.
