S—S	Make sign of "S"
Seed	Right hand palm down, rub four fingers against thumb
Gets sown all around	Use right hand to throw out seed from left hand
S—S—Seed	Same as above
Grows up in good ground	Right hand behind left, move up and spread fingers Thumbs up sign
