

Level 2—Parent Notes

- Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- Completion: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.

Daily Reading Questions

<u>Day 6</u>: What should we show to other people? How can we honor God? How do we show love to others?

Concluding Lesson

<u>Review</u>: Who do we have faith in? What things should we do if we have faith in Jesus? How do we honor God?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank Jesus for all the things he does for you. Thank him for dying on the cross for your sin. Pray that your faith in him will grow and he will help you do what's right to bring honor to him.

<u>Application</u>: Think of someone who is having a hard time. Pray for them and do something to show Jesus' love to them.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.
