- **Introduction:** (picture 19-1) What is this a picture of?

There was a woman who had been very sick for a long time. She believed if she just touched Jesus' clothes she would be healed. When she touched his garment she was healed. Jesus knew that power had gone out of him. The Holy Spirit gave Jesus the power to heal. The woman was healed because she believed in Jesus.

(picture 19-2) There was a ruler in the synagogue named Jairus whose daughter was very sick. He went to Jesus, fell on his knees and asked him to heal his daughter. Before Jesus got to Jairus' house, his daughter died. However, her spirit returned to her when Jesus went to her and told her to get up. She was healed because her father believed in Jesus.

Both physical and spiritual life come through Jesus. Physical life is what we get when we are born. It is the life we live here on earth in our body. Some day we will die and our physical life will end. Spiritual life is what we get when we believe in Jesus. It is the life of the spirit or soul. It never dies; it is eternal.

The big question for this week is: What is the life we gain through Jesus?

Listen as I read the lesson book and see if you can answer the question afterwards.

- **Lesson Book:** Read the book. Refer to the attached discussion questions.

Title: What is the life we gain through Jesus?

Page 1 – Psalm 51:5

(Picture of a baby)

(Picture of the cross)

Page 5 – John 3:3

(picture of child praying)

When Jesus lives inside you,
you are born again.

you're forgiven when you ask.
Then seeking life in Jesus
becomes your daily task.

Page 6 – Titus 3:5b-6

(picture of child with Jesus)

So give yourself to Jesus,
put your faith in God's own Son.
Let his Spirit live within you,
so that sin is overcome.
With his Spirit living in you,
you can live life well.
And with him up in heaven,
you one day will dwell.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Page 1: What happened when you were born? Who does life come from?

Page 2: Besides the life in your body what other kind of life is there? What is the part of you called that has spiritual life? How are you born spiritually?

Page 3: How is the body different from the soul? What gives life to your soul?

Page 4: What did Jesus do for you to give you life? How do you receive spiritual life? How did Jesus overcome death?

Page 5: What does it mean to be born again? What happens when you are born again? What should you seek every day?

Page 6: How do you give yourself to Jesus? What is the result of giving yourself to him?

Review: Select a couple questions from above to ask the students again.

- **Prayer:** Thank Jesus that you were given physical life in your body through your mother and that because you have physical life you can also have spiritual life. Thank him for dying for you and rising from the dead so that you can have spiritual life by believing in him.
- **The Big Question:** What is the life we gain through Jesus?

By believing in Jesus, we gain eternal life.

ACTIVITIES (Completed after the lesson)

Any age appropriate activity can be included which fits into the club time. The activities with a star are included on the weekly sheet.

- ★ **Coloring:** Color in the lesson picture.

★ **Activity:** Drawing

Instruction: Draw a picture of a tombstone and as a reminder that Jesus overcomes death.

★ **Lesson Rhyme:** Practice the lesson rhyme with movements.

L—L	Make sign of L

• **Discovery Activity:** Acting

Instructions: Act out what happened to the woman and to Jairus' daughter.

• **Craft:** Garment picture

As a reminder that the woman touched Jesus' garment and was healed, color in the pictures of Jesus healing on a piece of paper cut out to look like a garment.

Materials: copy paper, colored pencils, scissors

Preparation: Run off craft 19 on white copy paper

Instructions: Cut around the garment outline. Color in the pictures of Jesus on it.
