PICTURES NEEDED

20-1 Feeding of the 5,000

NURSERY CONCEPT

Jesus fed all the people.

LESSON CONTENT

Explanation: (Show lesson picture) (picture 20-2)

What is this a picture of?

The people came to Jesus because he drove out bad spirits and healed people who were sick. When the crowds gathered around him Jesus would talk about the things of God. One day the people were there listening to him until very late and had nothing to eat. Jesus had the people sit in groups of 50 each. He took the little bit of bread and fish that there was, gave thanks to the Father, broke them into pieces and had the disciples pass out the food to the crowds. The little bit of food became enough for everyone to eat. There were even 12 baskets full of food leftover.

QUESTIONS

Why did the people come to Jesus?

What did Jesus do for them when they had nothing to eat?

PRAYER

Thank Jesus that he wants to teach us about God the Father. Thank him that he also is our healer and provides what we need for life.

BIG QUESTION (This is for reference only. The nursery children are not expected to learn it.)

How does Jesus want to feed us?

Jesus wants to satisfy our souls.
