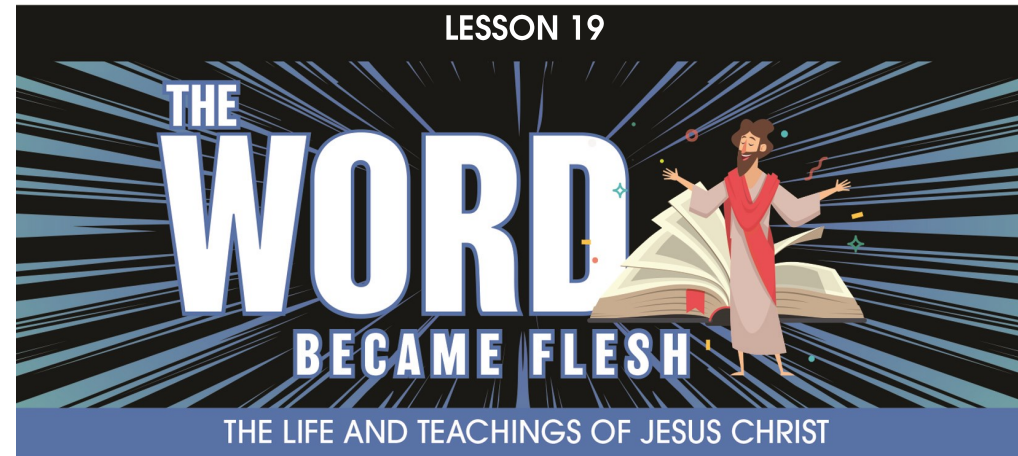

Level 2—Parent Notes

- ⇒ **Daily Journal:** Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the *Daily Reading Questions*. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ **Lesson Rhyme:** Read the *Lesson Rhyme* on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the *Lesson Rhyme Signs*.
- ⇒ **Concluding Lesson:** Complete the activities under *Concluding Lesson* in the booklet.
- ⇒ **Completion:** If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.
- ⇒ **Way to go, parents!** Your faithfulness in teaching your children the deeds and statutes of the Lord isn't always easy, but it honors God and will have an eternal impact. Keep up the good work! Daily Reading Questions 19

Day 1: What happened when you were born? What is physical life?

Day 2: Besides the life in your body what other kind of life is there? What is the part of you called that has spiritual life? How are you born spiritually?

Day 3: How is the body different from the soul? What gives life to your soul?

Day 4: What did Jesus do for you to give you life? How do you receive spiritual life? How did Jesus overcome death?

Day 5: What does it mean to be born again? What happens when you are born again? What should you seek every day?

Day 6: How do you give yourself to Jesus? What is the result of giving yourself to him?

Concluding Lesson

Review: What are the two types of life? How is the body different from the soul? How do you receive spiritual life?

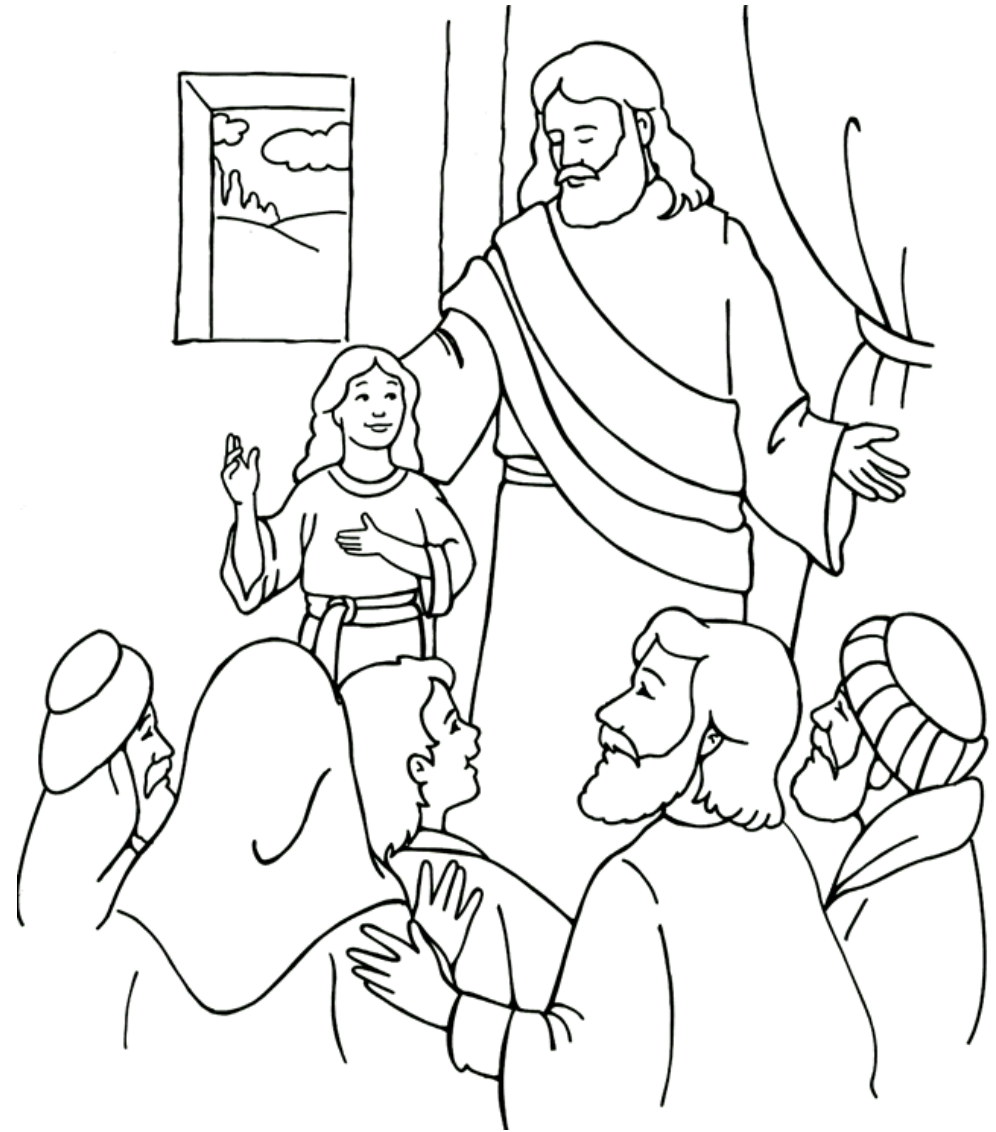
Prayer: Thank Jesus that you were given physical life in your body through your mother and that because you have physical life you can also have spiritual life. Thank him for dying for you and rising from the dead so that you can have spiritual life by believing in him.

Application: Examine the difference between a dead leaf and a live one then discuss the difference between life and death. What causes a leaf to die? What does a leaf have to do to remain alive?

Dictation: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.

| L—L | Make sign of L |
| Life | Put hands in front of body with palms facing body, wiggle fingers and move hands up |
| Belief in | Point to forehead |
| Jesus' name | Make sign of Jesus |
| L—L—Life | Same as above |
| Death he | Hold both flat hands to the front with the left palm down and the right palm up. Move both hands in an arc to the left while reversing the palms orientation. |
