

Level 2—Parent Notes

- Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or dictate a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Rhyme: Read the Lesson Rhyme on the front page, saying the sound of the letter instead of its name. Point to each word as you read it. Discuss the meaning of the rhyme. Review and repeat the rhyme every day using the Lesson Rhyme Signs.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under Concluding Lesson in the booklet.
- Completion: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson rhyme memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.

Daily Reading Questions 21

<u>Day 1</u>: Why did Jesus go to the mountain? What happened there?

<u>Day 2</u>: Who appeared on the mountain with Jesus? Who are Moses and Elijah?

<u>Day 3</u>: What did the disciples see? What is God's glory? What did the disciples hear coming from the cloud?

<u>Day 4</u>: What did the Father say about his Son?

<u>Day 5</u>: How did the disciples respond to what they saw and heard? What should we do with what we know about Jesus?

<u>Day 6</u>: What are ways we can see God's glory? How do they show God's glory

Concluding Lesson

<u>Review</u>: Why did Jesus go to the mountain? What happened there? Who appeared on the mountain with Jesus? Who are Moses and Elijah? What did the Father say about his Son?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank God for sending his Son to earth to reveal his glory and die for our sins. Pray that as you put your faith in Jesus you would understand him more, see his glory more fully and reflect him in your life.

<u>Application</u>: Read about what happened to Moses when he spoke with God and was in the presence of his glory in Exodus 34:29-35.

<u>Dictation</u>: Have the child dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson. Have the child repeat back the dictation, trace over the letters and draw a picture to go with it.


