

Level 3—Parent Notes

- Daily Journal: Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the Daily Reading Questions. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or write a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ Lesson Verse: The lesson verse which answers the week's big question should be practiced daily. One way to do this is to black out words in the verse each day and repeat the verse inserting the correct word. By the end of the week the whole verse would be blacked out and recited by memory. Depending on the age and/or ability of the child, either the whole verse or the part of the verse between brackets on the cover can be memorized.
- ⇒ Concluding Lesson: Complete the activities under the Concluding Lesson. In the booklet.
- Completion: If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson verse memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.
- ⇒ Way to go, parents! Your faithfulness in teaching your children the deeds and statutes of the Lord isn't always easy, but it honors God and will have an eternal impact. Keep up the good work!

<u>Day 3</u>: How is the body different from the soul? What gives life to your soul?

<u>Day 4</u>: What did Jesus do for you to give you life? How do you receive spiritual life? How did Jesus overcome death?

<u>Day 5</u>: What does it mean to be born again? What happens when you are born again? What should you seek every day?

<u>Day 6</u>: How do you give yourself to Jesus? What is the result of giving yourself to him?

<u>Review</u>: What are the two types of life? How is the body different from the soul? How do you receive spiritual life?

<u>Prayer</u>: Thank Jesus that you were given physical life in your body through your mother and that because you have physical life you can also have spiritual life. Thank him for dying for you and rising from the dead so that you can have spiritual life by believing in him.

<u>Application</u>: Examine the difference between a dead leaf and a live one then discuss the difference between life and death. What causes a leaf to die? What does a leaf have to do to remain alive?

<u>Thinking It Through</u>: Have the child write or dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson, how he/she can apply that truth, and a prayer to God.

Day 1— Psalm 51:5
