Level 3—Parent Notes

- ⇒ **Daily Journal:** Each day read the Scripture and discuss what it means. Then read the poem and have the child answer questions about it from the *Daily Reading Questions*. Include personal ideas and additional questions. Under the daily poem have the child draw a picture related to the content or write a sentence about what it means.
- ⇒ **Lesson Verse:** The lesson verse which answers the week's big question should be practiced daily. One way to do this is to black out words in the verse each day and repeat the verse inserting the correct word. By the end of the week the whole verse would be blacked out and recited by memory. Depending on the age and/or ability of the child, either the whole verse or the part of the verse between brackets on the cover can be memorized.
- ⇒ **Concluding Lesson:** Complete the activities under the *Concluding Lesson*. In the booklet.
- ⇒ **Completion:** If the student brings this booklet back to the teacher on Sunday, with each day's work completed and the lesson verse memorized, the student will receive acknowledgement of a job well done.
- ⇒ **Way to go, parents!** Your faithfulness in teaching your children the deeds and statutes of the Lord isn't always easy, but it honors God and will have an eternal impact. Keep up the good work! 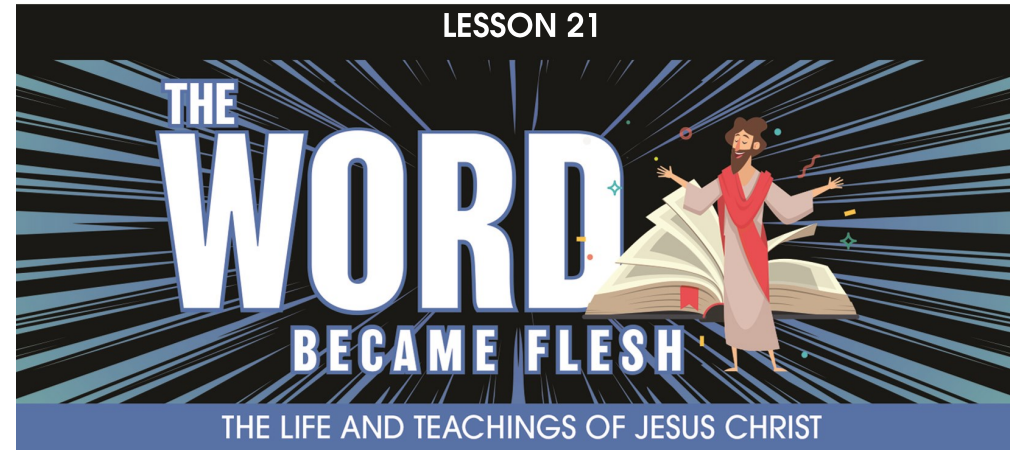

Daily Reading Questions #1

Day 1: Why did Jesus go to the mountain? What happened there?

Day 2: Who appeared on the mountain with Jesus? Who are Moses and Elijah?

Day 3: What did the disciples see? What is God's glory? What did the disciples hear coming from the cloud?

Day 4: What did the Father say about his Son?

Day 5: How did the disciples respond to what they saw and heard? What should we do with what we know about Jesus?

Day 6: What are ways we can see God's glory? How do they show God's glory

Concluding Lesson

Thinking It Through: Have the child write or dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson, how he/she can apply that truth, and a prayer to God.

Review: Why did Jesus go to the mountain? What happened there? Who appeared on the mountain with Jesus? Who are Moses and Elijah? What did the Father say about his Son?

Prayer: Thank God for sending his Son to earth to reveal his glory and die for our sins. Pray that as you put your faith in Jesus you would understand him more, see his glory more fully and reflect him in your life.

Application: Read about what happened to Moses when he spoke with God and was in the presence of his glory in Exodus 34:29-35.
